

The Finance Park program teaches middle school and high school students how to build the foundation on which they can make responsible and smart financial decisions that impact their lives, including the ones related to income, expenses, savings, and credit

Economics for Success

JA Economics for Success® is a financial education program that includes job and professional trajectories.

This program introduces concepts of personal finance and the importance of education and career planning to students from 6th grade in elementary school and 7th and 8th graders.
